The naturally beautiful Pelican Landing in Bonita Springs encompasses 2,365 acres bordered on the south by scenic Spring Creek and on the west by Estero Bay. The State of Florida designated an "Outstanding Florida Water" preserve leading to the Gulf of Mexico. Winding roadways throughout Pelican Landing Bonita Springs are shadowed by majestic live oaks, pine trees, and other native trees and vegetation.

Intimate neighborhoods in Pelican Landing Bonita Springs are filled with wild palmettos, slash pines, and Florida's state tree, the sabal palm. Within Pelican Landing is The Colony, an 809-acre private enclave situated at the community's N.W. corner on Estero Bay. The developer of Pelican Landing is WCI Communities, a nationally recognized leader in the field of community development.

Pelican Landing residents may purchase an equity golf membership at Pelican Nest Club for \$40,000. There are 36 holes. The golf course was designed by Tom Fazio and is rated in the top-25 of its kind in the nation by Golf Digest Magazine. Pelican Landing has manned gatehouses located at the entrances to the community and a roving patrol to ensure privacy and monitor activity. The tennis court includes a pro shop, fitness center and 12 HydroCourt clay courts (seven lighted) with a state-of-the-art subsurface irrigation system.

Residents of Pelican Landing are eligible to join Pelican Isle Yacht Club, just 10 minutes south at Wiggins Pass. Located less than 1 mile from the Gulf of Mexico, the club offers boating facilities with direct Gulf access. Pelican Landing offers several dining experiences, including a casual indoor-outdoor eatery overlooking Spring Creek. Located on 34 acres at the northern tip of Big Hickory Island, the Pelican Landing beach park provides a mile of white sand beach along the Gulf of Mexico. Transportation is provided to the private beach park by a water taxi that makes hourly trips seven days a week from Coconut Point. The Pelican Landing canoe park is located on Spring Creek; it is a quiet meandering tributary of Estero Bay and has been named "Outstanding Water" by the State of Florida.
